Main idea

Jesus Makes Us New

'(5) God himself has prepared us

- for this, and as a guarantee he has given us his Holy Spirit.
 (6) So we are always confident, even though we know that as long as we live in these hodies.
- even though we know that as long as we live in these bodies we are not at home with the Lord.
- (7) For we live by believing and not by seeing.
- (8) Yes, we are fully confident, and we would rather be away from these earthly bodies, for then we will be at home with the Lord.
- (9) So whether we are here in this body or away from this body, our goal is to please him.
