Opening Thought

In Acts Chapter 10, God reveals his desire to make not just the Jews into his chosen people, but to include even the Gentiles in his master plan of redemption. The message of the gospel is meant to be preached to all people everywhere.

Ice breakers

- Are there people you have a hard time understanding?
Example: Michigan fans, people that like snow, etc... how do you find common ground with the people you have a hard time understanding?

Dig Deeper



- What is the gospel? How would you communicate it to an unbeliever?
- Do you ever take it for granted that you are allowed to be a part of God's kingdom?
- Cornelius loved God, but if he would have heard the gospel and rejected Christ... he would have been lost. Why is Jesus so essential to our salvation?
- What would it look like for your core group to take the call to spread the gospel to heart? What could you do together to help advance the kingdom of God?
- What is the importance of baptism?
- What stood out to you from today's sermon?
