# **Opening Thought**

Jesus is the Prince of Peace. The early Anabaptists emphasized following in his ways and overcoming evil, not with violence, but with good. When Christ is Lord of your life, you experience peace with God, peace with others, and peace within. This is one of the most radical of teachings of our Lord. "If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also." (Matthew 5:39) This sort of radical faith leaves a legacy for generations to come, and it advances our mission of sharing the life-giving power of Jesus with the world.

#### Ice breaker

- As a kid, were you more of a troublemaker or a peacemaker?
- When have you seen someone not retaliate when they could have?

#### **Dig Deeper**

- What tends to be your response when you are wronged?
- We are often drawn to stories where vengeance is served. Why is that?
- Read Romans 12:14-21. What stands out to you?
- Paul says that we are to endure the harm without giving it back. Does this mean we are passive and just take the harm being done to us? Explain your answer.
- What is your response to "do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good?" How does that even work?
- How does a peace witness proclaim Christ to unbelievers?
- What things are posing the greatest threat to you having peace in this season? Circumstances, people, your attitude, the political divide, etc.

## Closing

What steps do you need to take this week toward reconciling with someone? What hurt do you need to take to the Lord? Once we have placed the desire for vengeance into the Lord's hands, we are freed up to love our enemies and do good to them. Our focus can be on mercy because we know God is just.
