# Key verse

## 3 Keys to being a worshipper

1. Worship with your actions

I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. Psalm 139:14

2. Worship with your attitude

The Lord says: These people come near to me with their mouth and honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Their worship of me is based on merely human rules they have been taught.

Isaiah 29:13

3. Worship everyday

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy to offer yourselves as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – which is your spiritual worship. Romans 12:1

# **Opening Thought**

- What stood out to you from today's sermon?
- What are the promises of God that always bring you back to an attitude of worship?
