Opening Thought

Ice breakers

- What was your favorite part of the program this morning?

Dig Deeper

- What can we learn from Hannah about being a godly parent? About being a follower of the Lord?
- Read Hannah's prayer of praise in 1 Samuel 2:1-10. List what she says about God and about herself.
- In what ways are you growing in your prayer life? In what ways do you *want* to grow?
- During Hannah's time there was a strong stigma about barrenness. Does it exist in our culture today as well? How can we support those who experience it?
- How do you respond when the Lord doesn't seem to answer your prayers?
- What avenues do people sometimes take rather than bringing their disappointments to the Lord?
- What practical steps can you take to honor the godly women in your life?

Closing

Keep trusting the Lord, even when he doesn't seem to be answering your prayers. Keep worshipping him in every season. And keep thanking the Lord for the special women he has put in your life.
